



SUMMARY OF MART SERVICES

MART uses the “flag down” system. This allows you to wave down a bus in transit anywhere along the route, as well as at noted stops. The bus will stop to pick you up, as long as it is safe to do so. Due to various unexpected conditions, traffic, weather, we recommend to arrive ten minutes before the scheduled stop time, and to wait at least ten minutes after the scheduled departure time.

Reduced Fare Identification Cards

Elderly/Disabled ID Card/MART's "Pink ID" Card

Reduced Fare on MART buses and MBTA Commuter Train only. Must be 60 or older transportation disabled and live in a MART member community. To obtain an application please call 800-922-5635 or 978-345-7711.

Transportation Access Pass/StateWide ID

Reduced fare on public transportation statewide. Disabled under 60 years old with approved application. To obtain an application please call 800-922-5635 or 978-345-7711.

MART Payment and Service Information

Transfers

Transfers are available on Fitchburg, Leominster and Lunenburg buses, and will be issued only upon the payment of fare. No transfers are available on the Fitchburg/Leominster-to-Gardner bus or on the MWCC Commuter Rail bus. Transfers are valid only at MART's Intermodal Transportation Center in Fitchburg and at Monument Square in Leominster. Transfers must be used within 2 hours. MART does not charge for transfers.

Commuter Checks

Commuter Checks and vouchers may be redeemed for bus passes, ADA Service or MART's Subscription Service. They are provided tax-free by employers. Commuter Checks are an employee benefit. Contact your Human Resources Department to find out if your company offers this service.
