

ATTENTION:

Per the CDC recommendation, on April 30, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) extended the face mask requirement for all transportation networks, including public transportation, through **September 13, 2021**.

Per Governor Baker effective May 29, 2021 the Commonwealth's mask order is rescinded. (**HOWEVER**) The Department of Public Health has issued a new mask advisory consistent with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's updated guidance. "**Masks are still mandatory for all individuals on public and private transportation systems (including rideshares, livery, taxi, ferries, MBTA, Commuter Rail and transportation stations)**, in healthcare facilities and in other settings hosting vulnerable populations, such as congregate care settings."

THIS MEANS:

Masks are still required on all MART buses and paratransit vans, as well as MART facilities. This also applies to taxi service (JARC/Devens).
