- Auditors Report FY2019

James went over the year to date financial summary (attached). MART finished FY2019 with a \$1.2 million deficit. The causes of the deficit for FY2019 are as follows:

- o Loss of Athol Earmark \$250,000
- o TLT legal expenses \$500,000
- Subscription Service clients did not reduce as planned after a significant price increase.
 Now using taxi-based service to help reduce costs. \$500,000
- State Contract Assistance level funding \$350,000

MART will not increase the RAN or reduce service because of the deficit. MART is in a position to cash flow out the deficit.

Bruce Norling went over the Audit Report with the Committee. The audit had no findings and over 60% of the Federal awards were tested for compliance.

11:08 am MART staff left and the Committee met alone with the Auditor to ask questions. 11:13 am MART staff returned and the meeting reconvene.

Mayor Stephen DiNatale from Fitchburg moved to accept and recommend the Auditor's Report and Audit to the MART Advisory Board. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
