

**THERE IS NO FARE FOR THE FOLLOWING
FITCHBURG STATE UNIVERSITY ROUTES:**

**Fitchburg State University Shuttle
Runs only during Fall & Spring College Sessions***

Route: Intermodal Center, Fitchburg State University (Dining Hall), Wallace Civic Center Parking Lot, Fitchburg State University, Intermodal Center

(Runs approximately every 15 min.)

Theater Block Service Monday—Friday		
Pick-up at Aubuchon Hall @ 8:30AM, 11:45AM, 1:00PM, 5:00PM and 6:30PM At these times the shuttle will go down North St from Aubuchon Hall, turn right on Main St and stop at the Theater. Then come back to the Intermodal via Boulder Drive and then proceed back to the normal shuttle loop service.		

** If a holiday falls on a Monday (ex: Labor Day), then Sunday service runs on the Monday holiday and not on the Sunday before it.

This shuttle (runs on a mini-bus) is supplemental to the Route 4 transit bus which runs Monday — Friday from 6:30 AM to 6:30 PM on the same 15 minute loop. The bus and shuttle are timed so that the shuttle and bus are running in opposite directions, giving a greater frequency with an 8 minute headway.

Route 4 is a free bus sponsored by Fitchburg State University & open to the public. No transfers are accepted or issued from this route.



- All MART buses are equipped with wheelchair ramps or lifts and reserved seating areas with chair ties.
- In the event a lift is not available to you because of an emergency or maintenance issue, your driver will notify MART, and a lift-equipped MART van will be sent to enable you to complete your journey.

Transfers are available on all buses (but not all routes) and will be issued only upon payment of fare. Consumers must ask the driver for the transfer at the farebox while boarding. Transfers are automatically recorded on the MART Card when used for payment. Transfers must be used within 2 hours. MART does not charge for transfers.

HOW TO RIDE MART

- Please arrive at your stop at least five minutes ahead of time.
- Flag the bus to stop at any safe location or wait in shelters.
- Signal driver by raising your arm as the bus approaches.
- Please have your fare ready when boarding the bus to avoid delays.
- Allow other passengers to get off before you enter the bus.
- After boarding please be seated immediately. If you must stand, please stay behind the yellow line and keep the aisle clear.
- Listen for your stop; all published stops are called out.
- To signal the bus to stop, simply press the black strip or pull the yellow chord beside a window as the bus approaches your stop.
- For safety reasons, MART has the right to postpone or cancel service or to deviate from its regular routes because of accidents, bad weather or other emergencies. Tune to WPKZ-AM 1280, call MART at 800-922-5636, or visit our website www.mrta.us for updates.
